

Notice: Revocation of Theta Chi Return Date

The University has officially cancelled the Fall 2027 return date for Theta Chi Fraternity. Despite clear directives from their national headquarters and the University to cease operations, the former members have continued to act as an unrecognized group.

As a result, the following now applies:

- **Indefinite Ban:** There is no longer a scheduled return date for Theta Chi. The actions of the current unrecognized group have effectively blocked a legitimate chapter from returning to campus for the foreseeable future.
- **Liability and Risk:** This group is not an official chapter of Theta Chi. It has no access to national insurance, no legal right to use the fraternity's name or trademarks, and no professional staff support.
- **Social & Campus Restrictions:** As an unrecognized group, this organization is not part of the University Greek community. **Recognized chapters (fraternities and sororities) are not permitted to host or participate in social events with this group.** Furthermore, they may not participate in University-sanctioned events, intramurals, or campus recruitment.

Students are encouraged to join one of the *many* **fully recognized** fraternities on campus that offer a legitimate, permanent, and nationally backed experience.
